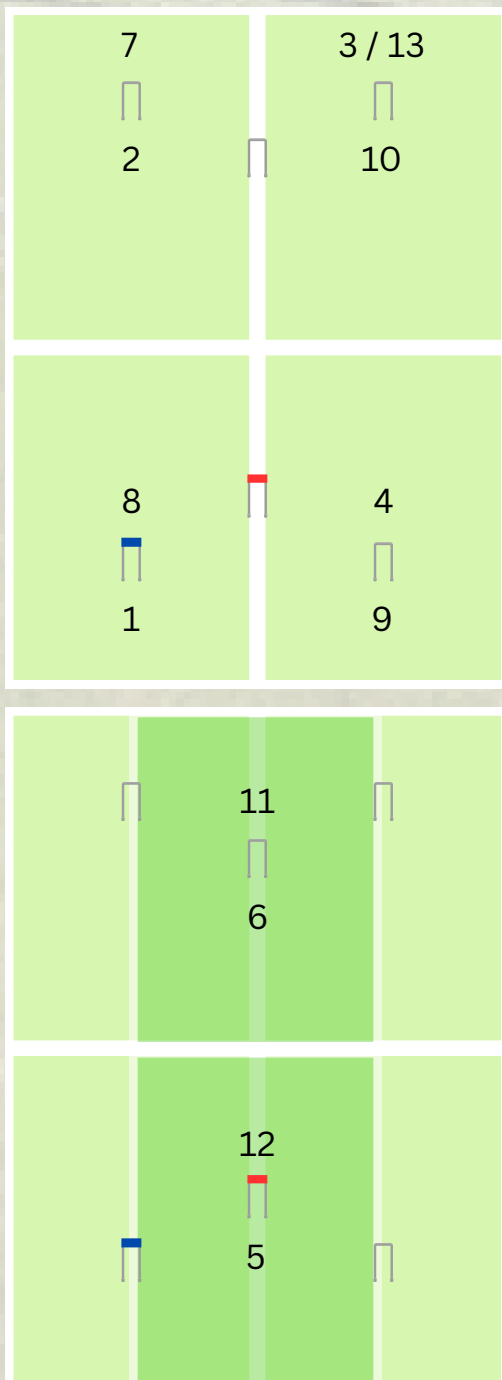


GC HANDICAP QUARTER SYSTEM



This system can be used in two ways:

Traditional

A Player gets an allowance of Quarters calibrated to his skill level and spends them at will at hoops of his choosing.

Dynamic

Quarters are available to both balls of a team whenever it is behind in the score.

GC HANDICAP QUARTER SYSTEM

SPENDING A QUARTER

gives two benefits:

A shorter start to a hoop: The initial shot to the Current-Hoop can be played as normal or from anywhere along the GC-designated Half-Way-Line between it and the previous hoop.

The ability to contain shots to the quarter of the lawn assigned to the hoop in play: Each hoop has a designated Quarter as shown overleaf. When a ball moves outside of the quarter for any reason, its path is reversed returning it to the nearest point on the edge of the Quarter. This reversal process can occur multiple times during the play of a hoop.
